Isaiah 40:28-31 KJV

"Has thou not known? Hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? There is <u>no searching</u> of His understanding."

How Great is our God who avails Himself to us, and is not hard to find?

Psalm 90:2 "Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God". **Psalm 147:5** "Great is our Lord, and of great power: His understanding is infinite".

Saints, don't throw in the towel. Command your attention away from yourselves and look by faith to our great God, The Author and Finisher of our Faith.(**Hebrews 12:2**) The prophet Isaiah gives us a message of comfort. He promises new strength for every believer. Rather than seeing hills and mountains, or rough terrain, think about the *Greatness* of God, the Creator of heaven and earth, (**Isaiah 66:1**) "The Lord says, Heaven is my throne, the earth is my footstool".

29 "He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he <u>increaseth</u> strength". God will sustain the weary by giving/adding power and multiplying your strength.

Jeremiah 31:25, 26 "For I have satisfied the weary soul, and I have replenished every sorrowful soul." **26** "Upon this I awaked, and beheld; and my sleep was sweet unto me."

30 "Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall;" **Philippians 4:13** "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."

Psalm 37:23,24 "The Steps of a good man are ordered (secured / established) by the Lord: and he delighteth in his way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the Lord upholdeth him with His hand."

31 <u>But they that wait</u>, upon the Lord, shall <u>renew</u> their strength; <u>they shall mount up</u> with wings as eagles; <u>they shall run</u>, and not be weary; and <u>they shall walk</u>, and not faint.

Isaiah 26:3 "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee; because he trusteth in thee."

Breathe. Meditate on who God is. Look for ways to glorify and serve Him, while you wait.
